Star Anderson - female 26 - singer

Lizzie - female 52 - record executive

Location

Lizzie's office

A record executive's office. Several framed records and pictures hang on the wall.

STAR ANDERSON, a young attractive recording artist nervously enters. SHE admires the pictures and plaques on the walls.

LIZZIE, a powerful record executive closes the door behind STAR.

LIZZIE

Come in. Have a seat.

STAR

Well... thanks.

LIZZIE

Let's get right to it. We have watched you develop over the last year.

STAR

We?

LIZZIE notices a picture on the desk. It's Lizzie and Queen Elizabeth.

LIZZIE

Let's just say me. But there is a we. So... I've been watching and I must say, impressive for an independent artist.

STAR

Thank you... Is that a picture of the Queen?

LIZZIE

It is.

STAR

So you're friends with the Queen?

LIZZIE

Yes.

STAR

Wow... well like, how?

LIZZIE

We've shared some of the same bloodline.

STAR hears something. Jumps, SHE looks, but there's nothing.

STAR

I'm sorry. Please forgive me. But, did you say the two of you are related?

LIZZIE

No... And like I said, you ma'am, are impressive. I would like to offer you the opportunity of lifetimes.

We hear a HISSING sound from under the desk.

STAR

Did you hear something...

LIZZIE pulls out a GREY CAT. (can be a stuffed animal)

STAR

AHHHHHH!

LIZZIE

Don't be startled. It's just my kitty.

LIZZIE watches STAR for a beat as STAR tries to catch HER breath.

STAR

That cat scared the crap out of me. Excuse me, but I'm a little nervous.

LIZZIE

Don't be afraid. It's just the little sneaky reptilian side of her.

STAR

Who? Um, what are talking about?

LIZZIE

I'm talking about my cat's reptilian side.

STAR

What?

LIZZIE

You know little. To get a cat, someone had to put two sworn enemies in the same body. That was the lion and the serpent. It was an experiment that gave us this little kitty we love today.

STAR

Uh... yeah.

LIZZIE

Look in the cat's eyes. In certain light, their eyes are light a snake. The creature you call a lion has eyes like a dog, and they stay that way. But this kitty has the same eyes as a snake. Did you hear the kitty hiss at you?

STAR

Yes.

LIZZIE

Does a lion hiss?

STAR

Um... no I don't believe so.

LIZZIE

All of these little kitty cats hiss like a serpent. That's the reptilian DNA. Enough about creating earthly creatures. I'm prepared to offer you a one million dollar signing bonus. Right now.

STAR

One million dollars? Wow... This is why I needed my manager to come with me.

LIZZIE

STAR hesitates, unsure, then...

STAR

Okay, um... please tell me more.

LIZZIE puts the cat down.

LIZZIE

STAR

But I write all of my songs.

LIZZIE

STAR

STAR

LIZZIE

STAR

STAR

LIZZIE

STAR

LIZZIE

STAR

LIZZIE

One million.

STAR

After taxes and all, I'll get half.

LIZZIE

Nice. You see how much wiser you are than that manager you had.

STAR

The manager I had?

LIZZIE

He's gone. You'll never see him again. Trust me.

STAR

What happened to him?

LIZZIE

He left when you said, okay, please tell me more. Now, my focus is you.

STAR

This is weird. Plus, he didn't even answer this morning. I told him about this meeting last week and he didn't even fuss when I said I had to come by myself. He normally does.

LIZZIE

He's the first of many. The higher you climb, the more people will be left behind. Like I said, my focus is you.

STAR

Okay.

LIZZIE

Great. Take a look at this.

LIZZIE opens a drawer on HER desk. SHE pulls out a folder containing papers. SHE hands a paper to STAR.

LIZZIE

You sold over 100,000 downloads on just that one platform this year. That's good. But not great.

STAR

I'm on more platforms.

LIZZIE

STAR

LIZZIE

STAR

LIZZIE

STAR

LIZZIE

STAR

LIZZIE

LIZZIE

STAR

STAR

LIZZIE

To the all. Now before you ask me too many question, you must ask yourself, how bad do you want what you want?

STAR

I don't think I want it--

LIZZIE

--Hush. I said ask yourself.

LIZZIE holds HER index finger up as a gesture to stop talking.

The lights dim when HER finger went up.

STAR sits in the chair freaking out.

LIZZIE takes a moment and looks STAR right in the eyes.

LIZZIE

You have this all wrong. I will give you the money you ask for. But understand, what I'm going to do for you requires more from you than anybody. Do you understand the power of your starlight?

STAR

Umm... no.

LIZZIE

Listen to me. You are not a shinning star, today. I am going to turn your inner light all the way up... full blast. Understand?

STAR

I think.

LIZZIE

When your light shines full blast, it's at the end of your life. It is never a good thing to turn your light all the way up so young. Your light will brighten naturally, little by little over the years. That way, you will be able to handle it and not burn out.

LIZZIE nods HER head and STAR nods back.

LIZZIE

STAR

No... No, I don't understand. You said you're paying me. Now how do I owe you back? And how do I pay?

LIZZIE

You pay it back with your soul. And sometimes the price you pay is larger than what you received.

STAR

SO YOU DO WANT MY SOUL?

LIZZIE

I told you no. But your soul is the currency.

STAR

But what the hell? I don't understand, if you say--

LIZZIE

--HUSH!

The finger goes up again.

The lights get brighter.

LIZZIE

The soul is the only thing that exist that can be used as current. And your soul does not belong to you. That is why you can not sell it.

STAR

Well, who does it belong--

LIZZIE

--It belongs to the all. The whole. Are you not listening? And you will pay with it... Forever.

STAR

Forever?

LIZZIE

It works like this. After you agree to this, a piece of your soul belongs to everybody who contributes. And you will owe each and every one of them.

STAR

Excuse me?

LIZZIE

STAR

LIZZIE

STAR
